Memory Book – Mrs. Thomas (Rm. 105): Students will create the MS Yearbook, take photos of events, and create a slide show for the end of the year.

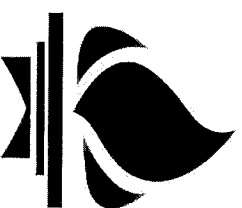
