



ANNVILLE-CLEONA SCHOOL DISTRICT MEDICATION DROP OFF

If your student has a chronic health condition or requires medication during school hours please review the following information.

Due to the unexpected school closure, medication and chronic condition action plans were not able to be sent home at the end of the last school year. The medication consent form and other necessary documentation is available on the [district website link here](#) for you to print and take to your student's healthcare provider for the upcoming school year. If you do not have access to a printer, these forms will be available at medication drop off (afternoon and evening events) or can be sent with your child during the first week of school at your request. Please obtain an order from your student's prescribing healthcare provider if you are unable to print the required forms. According to the Nurse Practice Act, nurses may not administer medications without a doctor order. This includes prescription and over-the-counter medications.

A medication drop off event will be held **at each building on Thursday, August 27 from 1pm-3pm** and a **combined evening drop off for any building from 6pm-8pm at the High School** during the [Community Drive Thru Celebration](#) the evening of **August 27th**.

Due to anticipated increases in student visits and for the health and safety of all students, students may not bring their medications to the nurse during the first three (3) weeks of school. If these medication drop off times do not work for you, please contact your building nurse directly to make another arrangement. Our nurses are monitoring emails and voicemails periodically.

Additionally, per CDC guidance, nurses will not be able to administer nebulizer treatments for asthma at school. The nurses may assist your student to use an inhaler with a spacer, if needed. If you have any questions, please contact your child's school nurse.
