Annville-Cleona Fall 2020 Spectator Plans

Revised September 29, 2020

Stadium (Football):

- All members of the varsity football team, varsity cheerleading squad and marching band will receive two (2) passes for home football games. The visiting team will be provided two (2) tickets for the parents for each member of the varsity football team.
 1. No visiting marching band or cheerleaders are permitted.
 2. **Spectators are required to space out a minimum of three (3) feet and must wear a face covering the entire time.** Bleachers will be marked to identify (3) feet spacing.
 3. Any Annville-Cleona students with a split family may contact the athletic office to receive two (2) additional tickets to accommodate their family situation.

Notes:

- No spectators will be permitted to stand along the track fence at any time in the stadium, all spectators must be in the bleachers.
- Movement in the stadium must be limited as much as possible.
- Signs will be posted that state the restrooms were cleaned prior to the game and prior to halftime and spectators should use them at their own risk.
- Hand sanitizer will be added to both entrances, at each entrance into the bleachers and will be available in the restrooms.
- Yard signs reminding spectators of social distancing, not congregating and wearing a mask will be posted throughout the stadium. Stadium announcers will also make announcements reminding spectators of these guidelines.

Stadium Accommodation Needs:

- The Marching band will be set up on the track area near the long jump lane (portable bleachers moved into this area for the band to use). The marching band must be socially distanced and wear face coverings when not performing.
- Visiting spectators will park in the back parking lot and use the back entrance, A-C spectators will use the front parking lot and enter using the front entrance. Officials will park at the auditorium parking lot and enter using the center gate.
- Additional portable toilets for visiting spectators will be placed on the visitor side of the stadium, which will be separate from the portable toilets for the visiting team.
- Additional event staff will be scheduled to confirm spectators are sitting in correct areas of the bleachers, wearing face coverings while moving around in the stadium (movement should be limited), and are not standing along the track fence.
- Police officers will be scheduled to help enforce the established and approved guidelines.

Additional Athletic Fields (Field Hockey Field and Soccer Fields):

- We will no longer check passes at the open fields. We request that spectators continue to socially distance and wear a face covering when moving around at the game or on campus.
- We will allow visiting parents at the cross country meet and request they social distance and wear a face covering while moving around on campus. We would have event staff to help keep spectators from congregating at the starting line and along the fence in the

stadium. We will also ask spectators to only arrive for their child's race and to leave following their race.

Consequences for Non-Compliance (proper wearing of face covering):

- Complete stoppage of the event with potential for forfeiture or reschedule without spectators.
- Pass(es) revoked for additional events.
